Vale is recruiting MBA students for Summer Job program in Brazil, Canada and Australia

Vale, the world's second largest diversified mining company, is recruiting until May 9 th students from the most important MBA schools in the world to take part in a Summer Job program in Brazil, Canada and Australia. This program aims to promote the access of talents from the best universities and to reinforce the company visibility in the international academic environment.

MBA students from the top 100 rated business schools by the Financial Times ranking are eligible to apply to one of the nine vacancies. Candidates can be of any nationality and need to be fluent in English. The ideal participant should have good communication, entrepreneurial and analytical skills, business orientation, interest in the business/industry and previous working experience.

Selected candidates will receive a monthly allowance of US\$ 4,300 to cover personal expenses, including meals and transportation, full assistance with visa issuing, round trip airplane ticket and health and dental plan. During the three months of internship, lodging costs and transportation to and from work will also be covered by Vale. The program is scheduled to start next June or July, according to schools summer break calendars.

During the three months of internship, students are expected to develop a relevant project to Vale applying acquired knowledge during the MBA course, related to strategic planning, marketing, finance, leadership, innovation and entrepreneurship. The Summer Job program is the first of four international recruiting programs that Vale will launch in 2008, as part of a major campaign to attract talented professionals to join the company.
